Autonomous Shuttle Demonstration



- **WHERE:** Near the Corps of Cadets dorms and Southside Garage on Texas A&M University's main campus.
- **WHAT:** Demonstration of autonomous low-speed shuttle with obstacles, pedestrian and bicycle scanning and avoidance.
- **WHY:** Demonstrate new mobility technology options and promote Texas A&M University as a leader in campus mobility. Conduct public attitude surveys and deployment evaluation.
- **WHO:** Open to students, faculty, staff and the local community.
- **WHEN:** Public deployment of 11-passenger shuttle and rides with a safety driver will occur Sept. 9–Nov. 15, 2019.
- HOW: Operational deployment Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
 The shuttle will be on static display in the Texas A&M Fan Zone prior to the Texas A&M vs. Lamar home football game on Sept. 14 and the Texas A&M vs. Mississippi State home football game on Oct. 26.
- **LEADS:** Texas A&M Transportation Institute and Texas A&M Transportation Services.
